

Literacy:

Phonics – Set 1 sounds c,k,u,b,f,e,l,sh,j,v,y,w

Listening to, and learning to retell traditional and modern stories, for example: Old MacDonald What the Ladybird Heard, Rosie's Walk, A Squash and a Squeeze

Talking and sharing stories we enjoy.

Learning traditional nursery rhymes, enjoys rhyming and rhythmic activities

Understand the five key concepts about print: - print has meaning - print can have different purposes - we read English text from left to right and from top to bottom - the names of the different parts of a book –page sequencing

Communication and Language:

Understand a question or instruction that has two parts, such as: "Get your coat and wait at the door".

Use a wider range of vocabulary.

To be able to follow instructions.

Speaking in sentences.

Listening to others and turn taking when speaking.

Sharing personal interests.

Mathematics:

Learning to find and match objects that are the same.

Learning to sort collection of objects based on different properties for example colour, size and shape.

Recognises numerals 1-10

Beginning to subitising.

Select a small number of objects from a group when asked, for example, "please give me one", "please give me two".

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

Form new friendships and building confidence.

Physical Development:
