

English:

In English, Oak Class will be using the Jane Considine "The Write Stuff" approach to explore the text Iron Man, focusing on descriptive writing, character thoughts and setting descriptions. They will also create a Year 3 magazine article linked to Climate Action, developing their skills in non-fiction writing, persuasive language and presenting information clearly.

Reading:

Oak Class will be reading "How to Train Your Dragon" to develop fluency, vocabulary, retrieval and inference skills. The children will be linked to Invaders and early British history while building confidence in answering VIPERS-style questions and using evidence from the text.

Mathematics:

In Maths this summer term, Oak Class will learn about time, decimals, money and shape through practical activities and problem-solving tasks. The children will also study position and direction using coordinates and turns, alongside statistics using tables, pictograms, bar charts and line graphs.

Curriculum Map: Summer Term

Oak Class

Art: We will explore craft and design through the topic Fabric of Nature .

Science: We will learn about sound, including how sounds are made, how they travel and how pitch and volume can change. The children will also study living things and their habitats, exploring how animals and plants depend on each other and how environments can change over time.

Music: We will explore ballads and learn songs linked to Vikings.

Computing: In Computing this summer term, Oak Class will develop computational thinking through simple programming and debugging activities.

History: In History this summer term, Oak Class will learn about the Vikings, including where they came from and why they invaded Britain. The children will explore Viking life, beliefs and the impact they had on Britain.

Physical Education: Oak Class will be going for swimming and also developing skills in athletics, rounders and tennis.

Design Technology: In Design and Technology this summer term, Oak Class will learn about electrical systems by designing and making torches while exploring how simple circuits work.

PSHE: We will learn about relationships and how people grow and change.

French: Oak Class will learn numbers 7–12, masculine nouns, animal names, vowel and consonant sounds.

Geography: We will learn about where food comes from and how it is produced in different parts of the world. The children will explore how climate, farming and transport affect the food we eat.

Religious and Worldviews: In this summer term, Oak Class will learn about Hindu beliefs and the importance of pilgrimage to the River Ganges.
